Ways to help keep Marshall Christian Academy a school of utmost Quality, Character, and Value

The tuition dollars of MCA are allocated to meet the basic operational needs of the school such as faculty and support salaries, instructional supplies and materials, physical plant operations, and debt retirement. If the school budgeted for all its needs for the year the tuition cost would be raised approximately \$90,000 or \$500 per student. Our school does not “nickel and dime” our parents and grandparents to death. However, we have four major ways to provide for the needed funds for the school – the Auction, the “Stand Up for Kids” Annual Fund, Land Payment, and the Fund a Need.

1. **Our Annual Auction** – In the spring of each year, we sponsor a school auction which is a fun -filled gala which provides the majority of money needed for the school year. We encourage each parent, grandparent, and friend of the school to volunteer, secure donations, sell ads, buy your tickets and attend the annual auction.
2. **“Stand Up for Kids” Annual Fund**

This fund is MCA’s annual giving campaign. It is designed to bridge the gap between what our families pay in tuition and the actual cost of operating the school. Fund gifts directly benefit all MCA students by providing the resources necessary for classroom materials and upgrades, teacher enrichment and training, teacher salary increases, tuition assistance, and technology. Additional funds will provide money for improvements in the quality of education and student life on campus. These unrestricted gifts to the school are greatly needed to insure the quality of our school remains at the highest levels possible.
3. **Land Payment** – The school has one more land payment of approximately \$24000. Donations have been given each year and we are looking forward to retiring this debt and move on towards planning and building in the near future.
4. **“Fund a Need”**- Each year the teachers and staff provide a list of items that are needed for the school. P.T.F. (Parent and Teacher Fellowship) and donors may designate their gifts to go directly to the purchase of these items. Call the school for a list of the 2010/2011 needs.
